



- 4. Exhibitors must report to steward before placing exhibits.
- 5. Each exhibit must have entry ticket, to be placed under each exhibit.
- Judging shall commence at <u>9.00 am</u>. Judges and stewards only permitted in hall during judging. Judges decision is final.
