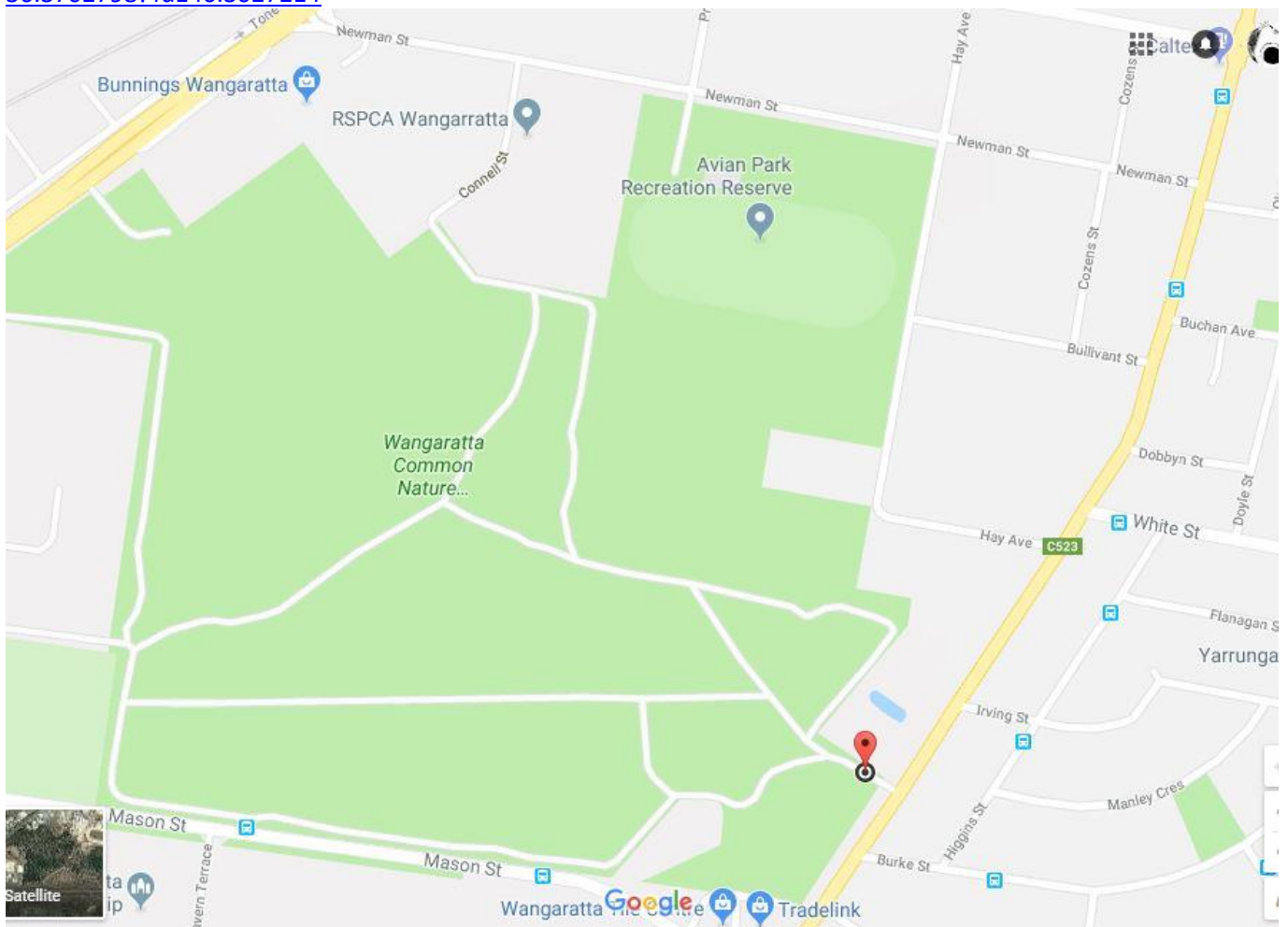
# Wangaratta Common Native Grassland Reserve – Field Day
